Request for Adoption of Park as Part of the Loleta Community Services District for Oversight-The lease with North Coast Railroad Authority/The Great Redwood Trail will no longer be renewable as of 10/19/23 unless the Loleta Community Chamber is able to find general liability insurance coverage for the park. Attempts to find insurance have been made without success. If the lease for the park is not renewed, all of the structures placed in the park by the Chamber will need to be fenced off or removed (play equipment, basketball court, picnic tables, free library, food pantry, benches, etc). The Chamber requests that LCSD considers contacting its insurance provider and including the park in the policy with the stipulation that the additional payments to the policy will be covered by the Chamber. LCSD will also have the responsibility to "watch over" the park and notify the Chamber of any issues in order to classify the park as "attended".

Request for the fee associated with bulk water meter rental to be waived for the local artist who will be power washing and then painting the storage container across from the creamery.

Request for the district to institute emergency response protocols for residents, including making available sandbags in the event of a water leak. Concerns over the availability of contact information/district website were brought up. One resident has inquired about the use of a District Facebook page for the sharing of pertinent information to Loleta residents.
